Duration: 15 minutes, estimated walking time without stops  
Start: Barón de Benifayó Museum  
End: Sea Museum collection

Description: Route the urban centre and the main museums that will help us learn about the history of San Pedro del Pinatar.

### Route 6: Virgen del Carmen Pilgrimage

Description: This route highlights the value of the festival declared of regional tourist interest, in which every July 16th the devotion to the Patron Saint of Fishermen is raised.

Description: In front of the "Las Salinas" visitor centre we begin this small route that will take us to the beach of El Mojón.

Description: This route proposes to walk along the northern part of the municipality's coastline through the beaches of the Mediterranean Sea

Description: On the Mediterranean coast, we find extensive natural beaches such as those of La Llana that offer the visitor transparent waters thanks to the posidonia.
